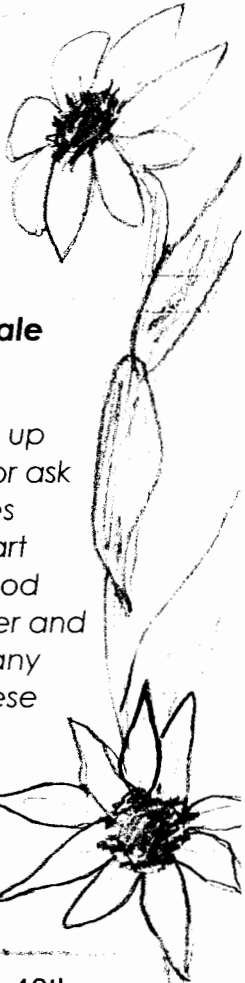

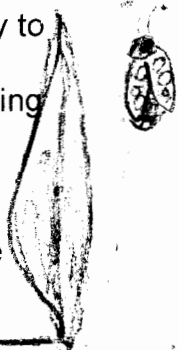

The Art Association in Roxbury was founded in 1965 by the Roxbury Woman's Club as one of its annual community improvement projects. These projects also included the founding of the Roxbury Public Library and the Dialysis Center. To publicize the new group, the Woman's Club held an open house with door prizes for the community. The first meetings were held at the Presbyterian Church in Succasunna and later on at the Temple Shalom on Hillside Ave. The early art shows were held at the Roxbury Municipal Building. **June Fairweather** was the first president. The club was incorporated in 1970. **Joann Gardner** and **Coleen Marks**, who still belong to AAR today, were among the original charter members, as was the past president, the late **William Shortridge**. Starting out with just 10 - 15 participants, the club has grown to over 100 members. Over the years, AAR has been active in the community and has continue to provide diverse activities and benefits for its members.

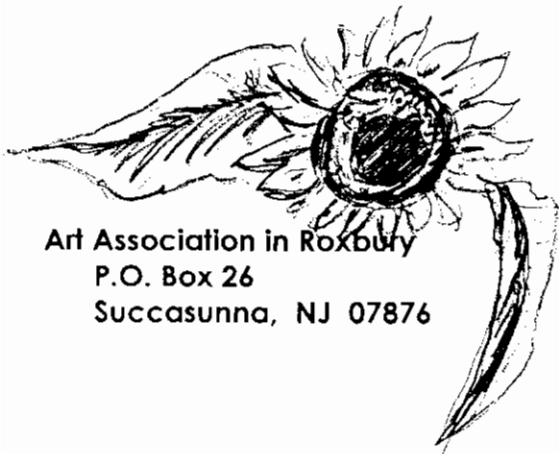
